The International Conference on Sustainability, Technology and Education (STE 2017) aimed to address the main issues which occur by assessing the relationship between Sustainability, Education and Technology.

This edition received 59 submissions from more than 12 countries. Each submission was reviewed in a double-blind review process by an average of four independent reviewers to ensure quality and maintain high standards. Out of the papers submitted, 11 papers have been published as full papers, which mean that the acceptance rate was 19%. These submissions include full papers, short papers, reflection paper and poster.

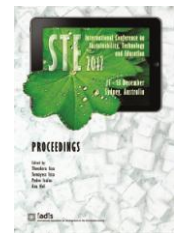
